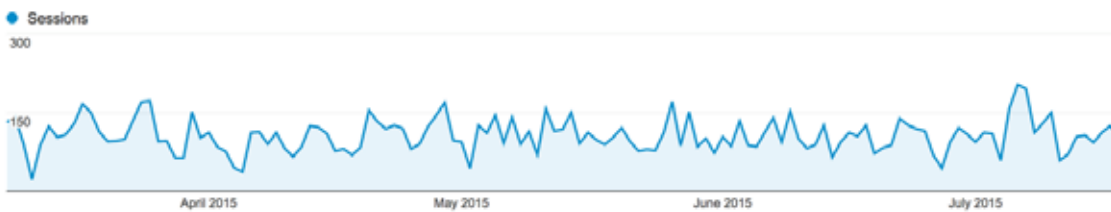

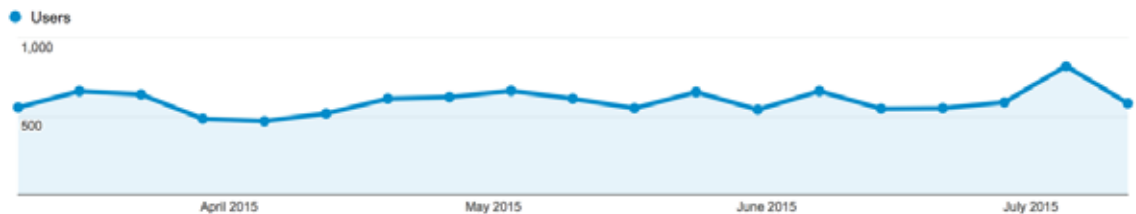

Analyzing the use of the Area 61 AFG website since March 2015 until July 2015, revealed fairly consistent daily use with a few dips and peaks (just after July 4th)

Average daily use is just under 100 users per day

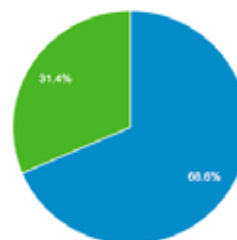


Average weekly use is around 600 users

Of the 10,000 users since the March 2015
68% of users have been new to the site.



Of the 14,209 sessions, 56% started on the home page, while 33% of the sessions started on the find a meeting page. Of the new users, 60% started on the find a meeting page. It should be noted that of the 14,000+ sessions only .27% (39) viewed the public outreach page.
