PROJECTS/GOALS:

1. Community Outreach continues to be a goal for District 12. We participate as part of a Family Panel at a local treatment facility about once every 4 weeks as part of their family component. District AFG members serve on panels or as speakers for open Al-Anon meetings the last Friday of each month. We have ordered and will be distributing 100 complimentary copies of "Al-Anon Faces Alcoholism" magazines as well as Al-Anon posters and meeting schedules to clinics, churches, hospitals, jails, etc. Although there were not enough nursing students to hold a class fall semester at CVTC, the professor has asked that if the class is held Spring semester, we provide members to share on the family disease of alcoholism as part of the class as we've done once before. We were told that the professor and students found the experience to be very beneficial.
2. Many of the District 12 groups in Eau Claire have implemented dilution statements as part of the meeting opening or as announcements at each meeting. The statements were formulated by a committee at District level in an attempt to bring greater focus on promoting unity and not diluting the Al-Anon principles. The statements suggest not mentioning other affiliations, not sharing/mentioning materials that are not CAL, and encouraging sharing only Al-Anon experiences during Al-Anon meetings.
