AWSC members should not be permitted to miss entire years with excused absences. Inactive members should be replaced with appointed members willing and able to serve.
3. The Assembly Agenda should have Other Business to give Districts and Groups an opportunity to bring an issue to the Assembly that may have arisen between the time of the AWSC meeting and the Assembly. We need to be flexible and willing to address issues of importance to our Groups.
