

Proposed Addition to Policy about Election Requirement

Proposed addition to Area 61 Policy Manual, Page 2, under *General Policies*, as a new #2:

To stand for Delegate or Area Officer, a member needs to have served a three-year term as a District Representative (DR), remained active at the Area level (as a Coordinator, a member of a Standing Committee, Thought or Task Force), regularly attend Area Assemblies and Al-Anon meetings.

Reasoning:

--From the Service Manual page 157:

"In order to draw on experience gained in service, an Area may choose to permit anyone who has served a three-year term as DR, has remained active at the Area level (as Newsletter Editor, Coordinator, etc.), and regularly attends Al-Anon meetings to stand for the office of Delegate. It is recommended that Areas have a process or procedure for handling this possibility."
